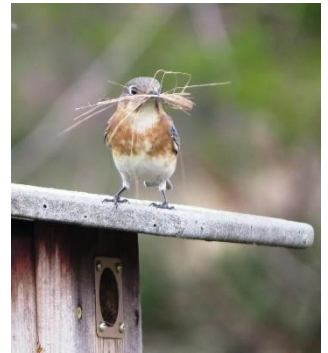


“Things we know little about” by Steve Buback

Steve Buback is a Natural History Biologist with the Missouri Department of Conservation and has been with the Department for 13 years. Much of this time was in Northwest Missouri, but he recently transferred down to Columbia, MO to work in the Central region. He served as the Heritage Entomologist for the Department for 10 years. **His main interests include finding and conserving rare plants, insects, and the natural communities they both rely upon.** He is currently on the Board of Directors for the Greenbelt Land Trust and the Missouri Native Plant Society. He currently resides in Columbia with his wife, Ariel, and two kids.

As a nutrition workshop leader, she realized human clients were way too addicted to sugar & junk food, Leslie soon returned to her native calling, focused on caring for mammals, insects, amphibians & birds on her 5 acre property in New Melle. She is now a Missouri Master Naturalist Emeritus, a Master Gardener Emeritus, and a native garden lead with the St Charles County Parks and the University Extension in St Peters.
